Whereas this Court has, in guardianship petition No135/3, under the provisions of sections 7/25 of Act No. VIII of 1890, been pleased to appoint you, **Mst Anam Aziz d/o Aziz ur Rehman resident of Minhaj House Thakra Tehsil and District Mansehra** to be guardian of the person of male minor namely **Ali Murtaza s/o Majid Qurashi (aged about 02 years)** during the period of his minority, subject to the provisions contained in the Act and the rules framed there under and particularly those provisions contained in sections 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 35, 36, 39, 44 and 45 of the Act aforesaid (which are printed on the back of this certificate), and also subject to the conditions mentioned below:

- The guardian will have to maintain and educate the minor in a good manner.
- Guardian would comply the provision of section 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 35, 36, 39, 44 & 45 as provided under the law of Guardianship and Wards Act 1890 in letter and spirit.
- The guardian will have to produce the minor in the court as and when required by the court.
- The guardian will not take the minor outside the jurisdiction of this court without prior permission from the court.
- The guardian will not act in such a way to prejudice the interests of the minor.
- The certificate would expire on 15th July 2042 by attaining the age of majority (21 years) by minor as per NADRA record.

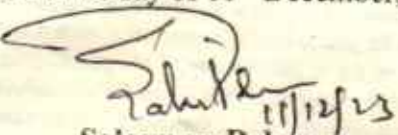
