Investigations

Summary: Patient got road traffic accident on 30-05-2025 and was admitted in the hospital due to motor vehicle collision, according to the medical reports issued, the patient suffered from : partial superior endplate compression fracture with underlying marrow oedema seen involving the L2 and L4 vertebral bodies partial disruption of PLL at L2 level, subtle focal oedema seen in left ligamentum flavum at L2 level, mild oedema seen in interspinous ligament at L1-L2 and L2-L3 levels, displaced fracture of right transverse processes of L1-L4 vertebrae, oedema seen in paravertebral region and in the right psoas and right paraspinal muscles.

Overall impression now and future needs:

Patient was reviewed today in my clinic, and his injury condition has stabilized and has become final in nature and character, as a result of the traffic accident that the patient experienced on the aforementioned date and we state the following :

Diagnosis

1. He still has pain in his back with difficulty doing his routine daily activity.
2. Patient has required physical therapy for minimum 6 months.
3. Avoid weight bearing, aggressive movements, lifting heavy objects and or to do sportive activity
4. He advised to take oral pain killers for his pain if needed.
5. According to the current situation, in consideration of the above finding his disability considered as 25% from the power of his back.
6. Patient is unable to go back to his work.
