Summary: Patient got road traffic accident on 10-06-2025 and was admitted in the hospital and discharged on 18-06-2025 (9 days) due to motor vehicle collision, according to the medical reports issued, the patient suffered from left shoulder pain, right hip pain, right femur deformity with shorting of leg, multiple bruise and abrasion over the upper and lower limbs, deformity and limited movement of the left shoulder and upper limb, right femoral fracture, displaced fracture of proximal end of left humerus, left humerus fracture.

DD:

Operations and Procedures done:
- Postoperative for open reduction internal fixation comminuted fracture of left proximal humerus operation - done on 13-06-2025.
- Internal fixation right femur operation - done on 11-6-2025.

Investigations

Overall impression now and future needs:
Patient was reviewed today in my clinic, and his injury condition has stabilized and has become final in nature and character, as a result of the traffic accident that the patient experienced on the aforementioned date and we state the following:

Diagnosis

1. He is suffering pain, walking with lameness and the inability to run, pain when prolonged standing and walking, inability to jump and sit in a squatting position, difficulty climbs and descending stairs, and cannot carrying weights on the left hand, also he is suffering from limited movement
2. He still has pain with difficulty doing his routine daily activity.
3. Patient has required physical therapy for minimum 6 months.
4. Avoid weight bearing, aggressive movements, lifting heavy objects and or to do sports activity
5. According to the current situation, in consideration of the above finding his disability considered as 45% of his walking ability, 35% from the power of his left lower extremity and disability of the skin can be calculated as 10% of the total skin.
6. Patient is unable to go back to his work.
